

Lacuna was conceived by three well seasoned wine professionals. We have held positions as wine consultants, sommeliers, importers, brand managers & wine brokers but this is our first venture into creating our own wine. After a few years working closely with Morgan Twain-Peterson of Bedrock Wine Co., our admiration for his wines and philosophy lead us to believe he would be the ideal person to make our wine. He was kind enough to agree.

LACUNA 2007 Red Wine, California

69% Syrah, 20% Grenache, 8% Zinfandel, 3% Cinsault pH 3.52 Alc 14.1%

Sourced from three amazing vineyards in California, the majority of this vintage came from a cool, high elevation vineyard at 2700ft with soil predominantly comprised of decayed Sandstone. Cropped at 2-2.5 tons/acre all grapes were carefully hand harvested and gently basket pressed. We transferred 40% of the wine to new French oak barrels and allowed 11 months of elevage.

High-toned, savory aromas reminiscent of white pepper, rosemary, and black olive are nestled in the warming embrace of currant and blackberry. Rich, dark fruit flavors linger on the palate. Seamless already, but the length and concentration suggest a few years in the cellar will be rewarded. 235 cases produced.

We hope LACUNA will grace your table.
